The ITC is a canine spay/neuter training center at Royal University of Agriculture in Phnom Penh. It aims to train local and international veterinary students in high quality, high volume spay/neuter of dogs.

Who we need

We are seeking Spay/Neuter Veterinarians for our ITC. <u>You are not required to be proficient in</u> <u>spay/neuter at the time of application</u>. A 2-months spay/neuter training will be provided to you at our ITC in Chiang Mai, Thailand.

As Spay/Neuter Veterinarian, you will join a team of 20 staff members, who are passionate about teaching surgical skills. You will work 8 hours per day, 5 days a week (Monday to Friday). Your responsibilities will be:

- Perform spay/neuter surgeries (up to 15 dog spay/neuter per day among several veterinarians).
- Train local and international veterinary students/graduates in spay/neuter techniques.
- Provide basic physical exams if required.
- Maintain an organized and clean working environment, equipment maintenance, etc.
- Maintain animal medical records.
- Closely coordinate with veterinary assistants and management staff.

As the ITC is currently under construction, you might be asked to work at our shelter/clinic in Boeung Tumpun for the first months, depending on your starting date.

You are an ideal fit if:

- You are fluent and confident in English and Khmer.
- You have a degree in Veterinary Medicine (DVM preferred).
- Preferred: You have a few years of practical work experience as a veterinarian or veterinary assistant.
- You get motivated and inspired by creating positive changes.
- You like to organize and keep track of patient records.
- You appreciate the excitement and are aware of challenges of fast-paced clinic work.
- You can anticipate what your team needs and complete it before someone else notices.
- You have excellent patient care skills and are willing to learn about animal handling techniques in order to provide stress-reducing care for your patients.
- You are a student of life, striving to learn when and whatever you can.
- You are committed to long-term employment.
