The International Training Center (ITC) is a canine spay/neuter training center at Royal University of Agriculture in Phnom Penh. It aims to train local and international veterinary students in high quality, high volume spay/neuter of dogs.

Who we need

We are seeking skilful Veterinary Assistants for our ITC. As Veterinary Assistant, you will join a team of 20 staff members, who are passionate about teaching surgical skills. You will work 8 hours per day, 5 days a week (Monday to Friday). You will have stand-by hours for selected weekends roughly once a month. Your responsibilities will be:

- Administer medical treatments and assist during surgery (15 dog spay/neuter per day)
- Caretaking of animals, if needed
- Observe animals and report signs of illness
- Maintain an organized and clean working environment, including equipment maintenance
- Clean and disinfect the working area
- Prepare surgical kits and all relevant supplies, including observation of stock
- Maintain animal medical records
- Assist the veterinary team in any other way necessary

There might be an option to receive training at our ITC in Chiang Mai, Thailand. This opportunity is not yet confirmed and will only be decided later on.

As the ITC is currently under construction, you might be asked to work at our shelter/clinic in Boeung Tumpun for the first months, depending on your starting date.

- You get motivated and inspired by creating positive changes.
- You like to organize and keep track of patient records.
- You appreciate the excitement and are aware of challenges of fast-paced clinic work.
- You can anticipate what your team needs and complete it before someone else notices.
- You have excellent patient care skills and are willing to learn about animal handling techniques in order to provide stress-reducing care for your patients.
- You are a student of life, striving to learn when and whatever you can.
- You have a Bachelor degree in Veterinary Medicine or Animal Husbandry.
